Exhibition Venue

"Black Sea Aerospace Defense Exhibition & Conference-2007" is being held at Romaero, a Romanian enterprise, specialized in providing aerospace manufacturing and repair (JAR 145 certified). Romaero's aerospace complex is located in the northern part of Bucharest and has direct runway access to the Baneasa International Airport (3,200m x 45m or 10,400 feet length). The exhibition and display site occupies a total area of 351,802 square meters with hanger space of over 700,000 cubic meters. Cranes and material handling equipment with load capacity of up to 300 tones is available. Baneasa Bucharest International Airport (BBI), the second gateway into Romania, it is situated in the north side of Bucharest, just 8 km to downtown.

Black Sea Defense & Aerospace Market Potential

The stability and democratic development of the Black Sea region, as well as its geographical proximity to the "arc-of-instability" ensures increasing sales of defense, security & aerospace technologies and support infrastructures. With a focus on "out-of-area" activities and the Global War On Terrorism (GWOT) coupled with US and NATO military realignment eastward and southward the Black Sea Region's importance will continue to expand, as well as increase sales for companies supplying defense, security and aerospace technology.

Romania, host country for BSDA2007, is geographically located at the junction of four areas: Central Europe, South East Europe, Eastern Europe and Black Sea-Caucasus-Central Asia, extending into the Mediterranean and Middle East. Its geo-strategic position is advantageous in promoting stabilization and engagement policy for these areas by developing intra- and inter-regional cooperation, in direct connection with international organizations, mainly NATO and the UN. Romania represents a catalyst for regional cooperation policies, considering its March 2004, accession into NATO. This will be amplified in January 2007, with its full membership into the EU. The anticipated expansion and growth for companies supplying defense, security and aerospace technology in the Black Sea Region is reinforced by the November 2005 signing of the historical "Access Accord" between the US and Romania. This Accord signed by US Secretary of State, Condoleezza Rice, and the Romanian Foreign Minister, Mihai Razvan Ungureanu, establishes four US military facilities on Romanian soil. These locations at Kogalniceanu, Babadag, Cincu and Smârdan, will be jointly used for training, drills as well as open for NATO exercises.

Additionally, the Romanian Air Force modernization doctrine foresees the replacement of the MiG-21 Lancer fighter with a multi-role fighter in the near future.

The Black Sea Region is the fastest growing, large economic area outside of Asia. It contains approximately 300 million people from the following countries: Romania (22 million), Bulgaria (8 million), Turkey (66 million), Russia (145 million), Ukraine (49 million) and Georgia (5 million). All are enjoying rapid economic growth and expect expansion of their civil air transportation requirements. In addition to the established national carriers, and following trends in the USA and Western Europe, new low cost carriers such as Blue Air (Romania), Hemus Air (Bulgaria) and Atlas Jet & Onur Air (Turkey), are creating new demand.

Romania has strong oil and gas industry, a large port on Black Sea and a booming tourist industry. It has a current GDP growth of over 5%, inflation is under 7% and unemployment is estimated at only 8%. The capital city of Romania, Bucharest ("Little Paris"), has a population of over 2 million and is rapidly growing into a modern European city.
